### Agreement

#### **for the assistance granted under the Project Preparation Facility Objective 1 of the Thematic Focus Area 4 - "Improvement of the Environment" included in the Swiss-Romanian Cooperation Programme to reduce economic and social disparities within the enlarged European Union**

Cluj-Napoca Municipality has completed the implementation of the Support Measures, the development of the Sustainable Energy Action Plan and the project outlines, financed by the Swiss-Romanian Cooperation Programme.

The Sustainable Energy Action Plan is a key-document that presents how the local government will fulfill its objective of CO 2 emissions until 2020.

In order to implement the principle of sustainable energy in a more efficient way, Cluj-Napoca's the Sustainable Energy Action Plan was developed after an initial analysis through the "European Energy Award" instrument and is focused on the following areas of intervention:

- Buildings, equipments/facilities
- Transport
- Local production of electricity
- Local heating/cooling
- Urban planning
- Public procurements
- Collaboration with citizens and stakeholders (communication and cooperation)
- Internal organization

Through the implementation of the Sustainable Energy Action Plan, Cluj-Napoca Municipality aims to achieve a reduction in CO 2 emissions by 20%, by 2020 compared with 2011.

Financial assistance for preparing the Sustainable Energy Action Plan and the project outlines that will be further financed, if the latter are approved by the Swiss partners, is provided through the Project Preparation Facility. The project outlines will be developed taking in consideration measures like thermal

rehabilitation of public buildings, heating, energy supply, public lighting, public transport and urban planning, measures that contribute to a sustainable energy management.

Cluj-Napoca municipality has also committed to undertake any steps needed for obtaining the „European Energy Award" certification.

The assistance provided through the Project Preparation Facility Agreement amounts to a maximum of 53.298 Swiss francs, which is the equivalent of 192.433 Lei.
